Post Op Instructions for Crown Prep / Temporary Crown

Try to avoid eating solid foods until the local anesthetic wears off. You may have no feeling in the surrounding area, including in some cases your tongue, and may unknowingly bite yourself.

Sensitivity is normal following the procedure; severe sensitivity/pain is not normal and you should contact the office to follow up.

It is important for the temporary crown to stay in place as to maintain coverage to protect the tooth. If your bite feels off, it is important to follow up before cementation of final restoration, as the temporary crown might need to be adjusted.

Avoid sticky and hard foods while you have a temporary in place, you need to maintain regular hygiene. When flossing, pull the floss out to the side so as to avoid pulling off the temporary crown. If the temporary crown should come off or break, contact the office to have the temporary crown recemented.

A temporary crown is just as stated, it does not in any way resemble the final restoration in color, shape or fit. It is only temporary.
